REQUIREMENTS:

Columbia Southern University

Bachelor's Degree: Must be a Sheriff's office employee and a member of the National Sheriffs' Association.

Master's Degree: Must be a Sheriff's office employee and a member of the National Sheriffs' Association.

Waldorf College

Bachelor's Degree: Must be a law enforcement agency employee and a member of the National Sheriffs' Association.

Applicant Procedure: You must submit a 500 word essay stating why the scholarship should be awarded to you and what you think is the greatest challenge sheriffs face today. This will be reviewed by the NSA Selection Committee.
