Seminar – Crisis Event Response and Recovery Access (CERRA) Effort

Description: The Crisis Event Response and Recovery Access (CERRA) Effort is an effort originally established by local and state law enforcement/emergency management and now endorsed by DHS NPPD, FEMA, and the ESS to establish a nationwide coordinated, interoperable, approach to enable safe, secure, and effective access before, during, and after critical crisis and disaster events. This effort uses a bottom-up approach in which local/state emergency management, law enforcement, and responding organizations coordinate to create an emergency access program. The emergency access program is a program run by local jurisdictions and interoperable with a national CERRA framework that ensures responders from out of the jurisdictions can receive immediate or tiered access to a crisis event. There are currently 15 state and local jurisdictions nationwide that have committed to adopting the CERRA framework, most of which have currently operational emergency access programs. The CERRA effort is currently in its second phase and is planning in 2017/2018 to publish the

national DHS CERRA Framework, the CERRA Standard, and the CERRA Clearinghouse (or toolset) which will be given to jurisdictions at no cost to ensure they can best run and coordinate their CERRA emergency access programs.
