

National Sheriffs' Association Scholarship Terms and Conditions

OFFICIAL RULES

NO PURCHASE IS NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN. A PURCHASE WILL NOT INCREASE YOUR CHANCE OF WINNING. THIS SCHOLARSHIP IS VOID WHERE PROHIBITED OR RESTRICTED BY LAW.

1. ELIGIBILITY: The National Sheriffs' Association ("NSA") and the University of Arizona Global Campus ("Program Entities") offer the NSA & the University of Arizona Global Campus (UAGC) Scholarship (the "NSA Scholarship"). The NSA Scholarship opportunity is open only to the following: Active NSA members ("members") that meet the requirements outlined below. - All applicants must be able to meet UAGC admission requirements as outlined in the UAGC Academic Catalog for applicable degree program level as well as meet all applicable international requirements by August 5, 2022 (8:59 a.m. PT); see below for applicable admission requirements.

 - Inability to meet requirements for admission in their entirety by August 5, 2022 (8:59 a.m. PT) will result in disqualification from scholarship selection.
- Applicant must not be an active student at UAGC; current UAGC students are not eligible to complete an application or receive the NSA Scholarship.

All federal, state and local rules and regulations apply. Void where prohibited or restricted by law.

2. HOW TO ENTER: The NSA Scholarship Entry Period starts on July 11, 2022 at 12:00 a.m. (PT) and ends at 08:59 a.m. (PT) on August 5, 2022 (the "Entry Period"). The scholarship Recipient ("Recipient") will be announced the week of August 17, 2022 (the "Recipient Announcement Date"). The NSA Scholarship is subject to these official rules ("Official Rules"). By entering, all applicants ("Applicants") agree to be bound by the terms and conditions set forth in these Official Rules. Certain restrictions may apply. To enter, visit the NSA Scholarship [landing page](#) during the Entry Period and follow the entry instructions. Applicants will be required to submit the NSA Scholarship Application (the "Application"). The University of Arizona Global Campus computer will be the official time clock for the program. Entries will not be acknowledged or returned. In the event of a dispute as to the ownership of an entry, the authorized account holder of the email address used to submit an entry will be deemed to be the Applicant. The "authorized account holder" is the natural person assigned an email address by an Internet access provider, online service provider or other organization responsible for assigning email addresses for the domain associated with the submitted address. The Recipient may be required to show proof of being the authorized account holder. Multiple entries will not increase chances of being selected. ALL ENTRIES MUST BE RECEIVED BY 08:59 A.M. (PT) ON THE LAST DAY OF THE ENTRY PERIOD TO BE ELIGIBLE. When you apply for the NSA Scholarship, you may be asked to

consent to receive promotional emails and reminders for promotions and information about online education. Consenting to receive such emails is optional and is not a requirement for participation in the NSA Scholarship and does not improve your chances of winning. Entry must be made by the Applicant only via the Application. Entries made by any other individual or any entity and/or originating at any other Internet website or email address will be void. The use of any device, hardware and/or computer software to automate the entry process is prohibited.

3. RECIPIENT SELECTION: On August 5, 2022, five (5) finalists will be selected at random. The five (5) finalist will have until August 15, 2022 at 9:00 a.m. (PT) to verify they are able to meet UAGC admission requirements. Failure to meet UAGC admission requirements by August 15, 2022 at 9:00 a.m. (PT) will result in disqualification and the applicant will not proceed to final selection. During the week of August 17, 2022, one (1) Recipient will be selected at random from the approved finalists. Selection decisions are final and binding in all respects. An alternate Recipient may be selected in the event initial Recipient declines the scholarship or is disqualified.

4. RECIPIENT VERIFICATION AND NOTIFICATION: Recipient is subject to verification. Recipient must reside in a state with available UAGC programs and meet all Eligibility outlined above (See #1. Eligibility). The selected Recipient will be notified by UAGC and/or Zovio Inc (third-party service provider for UAGC) by phone and email, during the week of August 17, 2022. If selected Recipient is unreachable by phone after reasonable attempts have been made to contact such selected Recipient during a period of seven (7) business days, or if a notification is returned as undeliverable, the selected Recipient may be disqualified. The selected Recipient will be required to complete and return the NSA Scholarship Acknowledgement and Release form prior to starting courses. Failure to sign and return all required documents within the specified time period may result in forfeiture and disqualification of the selected Recipient and an alternate Recipient may be selected. Specified time periods may be extended up to thirty (30) additional business days should an alternate Recipient be selected.

5. SCHOLARSHIP: A total of up to one (1) tuition-only scholarship will be awarded. The award consists of full tuition (Bachelor's or Master's degree program) for the pursuit of an online degree from the University of Arizona Global Campus. Receipt and use of the scholarship is subject to all policies, restrictions and conditions imposed by UAGC as set forth in the UAGC Academic Catalog, including without limitation all UAGC admission requirements. ALL FEDERAL, STATE AND LOCAL TAXES, AND ANY OTHER COSTS AND EXPENSES, ASSOCIATED WITH THE RECEIPT OR USE OF THE SCHOLARSHIPS ARE THE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY OF EACH RECIPIENT. The scholarships are awarded WITHOUT WARRANTY OF ANY KIND, express or implied, without limitation. If a Recipient chooses not to accept their scholarship, an alternate Recipient may be chosen. The approximate retail value of the scholarship will vary depending on the UAGC tuition rate, program level, and specific degree program but is estimated to be between \$19,950 and \$61,200. Any taxes on the scholarship value are the sole responsibility of the Recipient. Scholarship consists only of items expressly specified in these rules. Any costs or expenses associated with the acceptance or use of any scholarship (including, without limitation, Technology Fee (per course), books, course digital materials (CDM), instructional materials, Graduation Fee, Prior Learning Assessment (PLA) fees, transcript fees, all other fees, tuition for courses completed unsuccessfully, and living expenses) are the responsibility of the Recipient. Recipient is also responsible for the tuition cost for any courses that are unsuccessful as outlined in the UAGC Academic Catalog. No substitution or transfer of the scholarship or the right to receive the scholarship is permitted, except that UAGC may in its discretion substitute for any scholarship an alternate scholarship of equal or greater value.

6. CONDITIONS OF SCHOLARSHIP: The scholarship award will be granted to the Recipient in the form of a non-cash credit to UAGC, and no check or cash payments will be given and/or refunded to any Recipient at any time. Recipient must enroll in their program of choice within 90 calendar days following the award date or forfeit the scholarship award. Recipient found to be in violation of the Student Community Standards at any time during their enrollment with the University of Arizona Global Campus risks revocation of any scholarship awarded, at the sole discretion of the University of Arizona Global Campus. Receipt and use of the scholarship is subject to all policies, restrictions and conditions imposed by UAGC as set forth in the University of Arizona Global Campus Academic Catalog, including without limitation the University of Arizona Global Campus admission requirements, Satisfactory Academic Progress, and Attendance. Recipient must remain continuously enrolled or on an approved academic leave during their enrollment to maintain scholarship eligibility. Recipients who are out of attendance greater than 180 consecutive days will forfeit the scholarship award. Additionally, to maintain scholarship eligibility, Recipients are required to maintain their membership with NSA. Recipient cannot be receiving any other institutional offers or grants.

7. PERSONAL INFORMATION: Information collected via the Application shall be subject to the University of Arizona Global Campus privacy policy, which can be viewed at <https://www.uagc.edu/privacy/>. Applicants acknowledge that representatives of the University of Arizona Global Campus may contact them about enrollment opportunities at the University of Arizona Global Campus and/or may contact Applicants with future communications and offers.

8. MISCELLANEOUS: All Applicants release all of the Program Entities, and all others associated with the development and execution of this NSA Scholarship, from any and all claims and liabilities arising from or in connection with participation in this NSA Scholarship, the delivery, non-delivery, acceptance or use of any scholarship and/or the use of the Applicant's submitted application as permitted hereunder, including without limitation claims for injury, death, loss or damage of any kind. This NSA Scholarship is subject to all applicable federal, state, and local laws and regulations. The University of Arizona Global Campus is not responsible for lost, late, illegible, incomplete, damaged, corrupted, mutilated, misdirected, misdelivered, undelivered, blocked or delayed entries or other communications, or for technical or human errors, delays or failures of any kind in connection with the submission, transmission, processing, storage or judging of entries, including without limitation any malfunctions or failures of computer hardware, computer software, networks or telephone equipment, any data loss or corruption, or any technical problems or traffic congestion on the Internet or at any website or any combination thereof. The University of Arizona Global Campus reserves the right to suspend and/or modify the NSA Scholarship, or any part of it, if any fraud, technical failures or any other factor beyond the University of Arizona Global Campus reasonable control impairs the integrity or proper functioning of the NSA Scholarship. This determination will be made by the University of Arizona Global Campus in consultation with NSA. If the fraud, technical failures, and or other factors impairing the integrity or proper functioning of the NSA Scholarship cannot be resolved within a reasonable period of time, the University of Arizona Global Campus reserves the right to cancel the NSA Scholarship. In the event of cancellation, suspension or modification of the NSA Scholarship, a notice will be posted online. Failure by the University of Arizona Global Campus to enforce any term of these Official Rules shall not constitute a waiver of that provision. The Program Entities will not be liable to any Applicant or any other person for failure to supply any scholarship or any part thereof, by reason of any acts of God, any action(s), regulation(s), order(s), or request(s) by any governmental or quasi-

governmental entity (whether or not the action(s), regulation(s), order(s) or request(s) prove(s) to be invalid), equipment failure, terrorist acts, earthquake, war, fire, flood, explosion, unusually severe weather, hurricane, embargo, labor dispute or strike (whether legal or illegal), labor or material shortage, transportation interruption of any kind, work slow-down, civil disturbance, insurrection, riot, or any other cause beyond the control of the Program Entities. Applicants acknowledge that the Program Entities have neither made nor are in any manner responsible for any warranty, representation or guarantee, expressed or implied, in fact or in law, related to the scholarship award. CAUTION: ANY ATTEMPT BY AN APPLICANT TO DELIBERATELY DAMAGE ANY WEBSITE OR UNDERMINE THE LEGITIMATE OPERATION OF THE NSA SCHOLARSHIP IS A VIOLATION OF CRIMINAL AND/OR CIVIL LAWS AND SHOULD SUCH AN ATTEMPT BE MADE, THE UNIVERSITY OF ARIZONA GLOBAL CAMPUS RESERVES THE RIGHT TO SEEK DAMAGES AND OTHER REMEDIES FROM ANY SUCH PERSON TO THE FULLEST EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW. Without limitation of the foregoing, the University of Arizona Global Campus reserves the right at its sole discretion to disqualify any individual Applicant who tampers with the entry process. The University of Arizona Global Campus is not responsible for any typographical or other error in the printing or communication of the offer, administration of the NSA Scholarship, or in the announcement of the scholarship or the Recipient. Each Applicant agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Program Entities from and against any and all claims, liabilities and damages of any kind or nature, including without limitation any copyright infringement claim or claim of violation of the right of privacy.

9. DISPUTES: This program is governed by the laws of the State of Arizona without giving effect to conflict of law doctrines. As a condition of participating in this program, each Applicant agrees that any and all disputes that cannot be resolved between the parties, and causes of action arising out of or in connection with this program, shall be resolved individually, without resort to any form of class action, exclusively before a court located in the State of Arizona having jurisdiction, unless otherwise provided in agreements between the Applicant and the University of Arizona Global Campus. Further, in any such dispute, under no circumstances will any Applicant be permitted to obtain an award of, and hereby waive all rights to claim punitive, incidental or consequential damages, including attorneys' fees, other than participant's actual out-of-pocket expenses (e.g. costs associated with entering), and each Applicant further waives all rights to have damages multiplied or increased.
