On behalf of the National Sheriffs' Association (NSA), representing 3,081 sheriffs nationwide, we write to express our support for the S. 710, Crypto ATM Fraud Prevention Act.

Sheriffs across the country continue to encounter cryptocurrency kiosk scams that disproportionately target older Americans and other vulnerable individuals, resulting in significant financial losses and making recovery of stolen funds exceedingly difficult. S. 710 establishes commonsense safeguards by increasing transparency, requiring reasonable fraud prevention measures, and providing FinCEN with additional oversight tools to help deter criminal activity and protect consumers.

The National Sheriffs' Association appreciates your leadership on this important issue and is pleased to support S. 710, the Crypto ATM Fraud Prevention Act.
